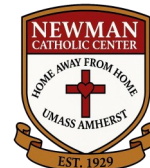

ONE HEART, ONE LOVE

Today the Church celebrates the mystery of the Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit: three Persons, yet one God, united perfectly in love. While the Trinity is a mystery beyond complete human understanding, we can still glimpse its beauty through the relationships we experience in life.

My father (God bless his soul) used to say: “A family eats from one pot.” Even though each person in a family has a different role; the father, the mother, the children, they remain united as one family. They share their joy together, carry their burdens together, and make decisions with the good of all in mind. Unity does not erase individuality; rather, love binds everyone together.

This image helps us understand something about the Trinity. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit live in perfect communion, perfect love, and perfect unity. There is no division, jealousy, or selfishness, only total self-giving love.

And this is not just a mystery to admire; it is a model for how we are called to live. In our families, marriages, parish community, and friendships, we are called to reflect the unity of the Trinity: to forgive quickly, to support one another, to listen with patience, to work together in peace and love. A parish becomes truly alive when people stop asking, “What do I want?” and begin asking, “What will help us grow together as the family of God?”

As we celebrate this great feast, may the love shared within the Trinity inspire our homes and parish community to become places of deeper unity, mercy, and joy.

“Holy, Holy, Holy” was written by Reginald Heber (1783-1826), Anglican bishop of Calcutta beginning in 1823 until his death shortly after. He wrote this hymn during his time in India. The tune, Nicaea, was by John Bacchus Dykes (1823-1876) specifically for this hymn. He so named it because the Council of Nicaea, which took place in 325, clearly defined the nature of the Three Persons, and also produced the Nicene Creed, which we say every Sunday. *Source: The Hymnal 1940 companion.*

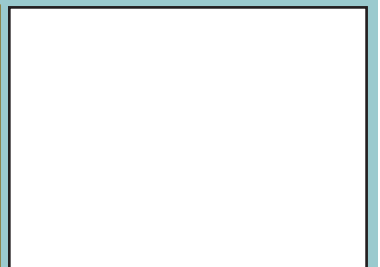
