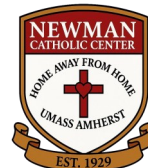

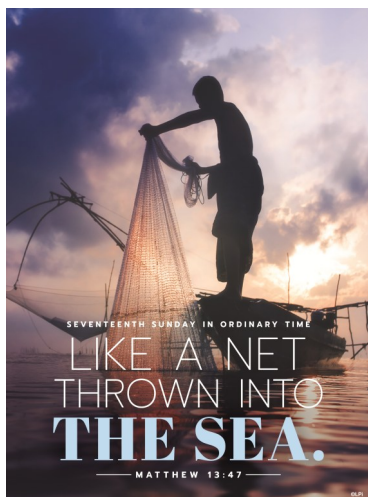

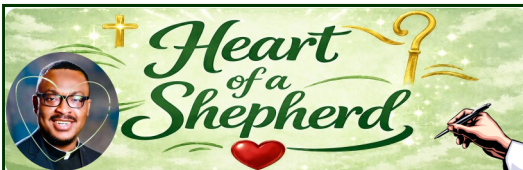

AN UNDERSTANDING HEART

I have always wondered, if God were to appear to me today and say, “Ask something of me and I will give it to you,” what would my answer be? Perhaps strong health, spiritual strength, peace in my family, a longer life, or maybe to become the next Bishop of Springfield. (Haha) Like me, you may also have similar or even better desires. None of these desires are wrong.

Yet, in today's First Reading, young Solomon asks for something greater: “an understanding heart.” Scripture tells us that “the Lord was pleased” with Solomon's request because he desired not riches or power, but the wisdom to understand God's ways and govern His people well.

The Gospel beautifully echoes this same wisdom. Jesus compares the Kingdom of Heaven to a treasure hidden in a field and to a pearl of great price. The man and the merchant joyfully sell everything they possess because they recognize something infinitely more valuable. Their hearts have learned to distinguish what is merely desirable from what is truly priceless.

This is the gift Solomon sought, an understanding heart. It is the wisdom to see life through God's eyes, to recognize His will even when it differs from our own plans, and to trust that, as St. Paul reminds us, “all things work together for good for those who love God.” Wealth can disappear. Health can fade. Success can be fleeting. But a heart formed by God's wisdom possesses a treasure that no one can take away.

This week, let us pray not first for more possessions or fewer problems, but for the grace of an understanding heart, a heart that recognizes Christ as our greatest treasure and chooses Him above all else.

Now you understand why I always pray: “Jesus, meek and humble of heart, touch our hearts and make them like yours. Amen.

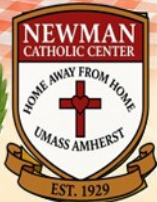

UN CORAZÓN COMPRENSIVO

Siempre me he preguntado: si Dios se me apareciera hoy y me dijera: «Pídeme algo y te lo daré», ¿cuál sería mi respuesta? Quizás una salud robusta, fuerza espiritual, paz en mi familia, una vida más larga, o tal vez convertirme en el próximo obispo de Springfield (Jaja). Al igual que yo, quizá tú también tengas deseos similares o incluso mejores. Ninguno de estos deseos está mal.

Sin embargo, en la primera lectura de hoy, el joven Salomón pide algo más grande: «un corazón comprensivo». La Escritura nos dice que «el Señor se complació» con la petición de Salomón porque este no deseaba riquezas ni poder, sino la sabiduría para comprender los caminos de Dios y gobernar bien a su pueblo.

El Evangelio se hace eco de esta misma sabiduría de forma maravillosa. Jesús compara el Reino de los Cielos con un tesoro escondido en un campo y con una perla de gran valor. El hombre y el mercader venden con alegría todo lo que poseen porque reconocen algo infinitamente más valioso. Sus corazones han aprendido a distinguir lo que es meramente deseable de lo que es verdaderamente inestimable.

Este es el don que Salomón buscaba: un corazón comprensivo. Es la sabiduría para ver la vida a través de los ojos de Dios, para reconocer su voluntad incluso cuando difiere de nuestros propios planes, y para confiar en que, como nos recuerda san Pablo, «todas las cosas cooperan para el bien de los que aman a Dios». La riqueza puede desaparecer. La salud puede desvanecerse. El éxito puede ser efímero. Pero un corazón formado por la sabiduría de Dios posee un tesoro que nadie puede arrebatarlos.

Esta semana, recemos no en primer lugar por más posesiones o menos problemas, sino por la gracia de un corazón comprensivo, un corazón que reconozca a Cristo como nuestro mayor tesoro y lo elija por encima de todo lo demás. Ahora entiendes por qué siempre rezo: «Jesús, manso y humilde de corazón, toca nuestros corazones y hazlos como el tuyo. Amén».
