

LET YOUR LOVE SHINE

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples, "You are the light of the world... your light must shine before others." He is reminding us that faith is not meant to be hidden. It is meant to be seen in the way we love, serve, forgive, and care for one another.

How fitting that this message comes as we approach St. Valentine's Day, a day often associated only with romantic love. While marriage and romance are beautiful gifts, Christian love is much wider and deeper. It includes friendship, family bonds, compassion for neighbors, kindness to strangers, and care for those who feel forgotten.

St. Valentine himself was remembered not for chocolates or cards, but for courageous love, serving others, blessing marriages, and witnessing to Christ even when it was difficult. Real love is not just a feeling; it is a decision to seek the good of another person.

Jesus calls us to be light by loving in everyday ways: A kind word when someone is discouraged, Patience with a family member, A visit or phone call to someone who is lonely, A helping hand offered without being asked. These small acts are how God's light and love shine through us.

That spirit of joyful Christian love is exactly what we hope to celebrate at our Parish Valentine's Dinner and Dance next Saturday. This evening is not only for couples, it is for everyone in our parish family: friends, widows and widowers, young adults, students, seniors, and anyone who wants to share good food, laughter, and community. Love in the Christian sense is about belonging, and no one in our parish should feel left out. So join us at 6pm at the Parish Center Gymnasium.



DEJA QUE TU AMOR BRILLE

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dice a sus discípulos: «Ustedes son la luz del mundo... su luz debe brillar ante los demás». Nos recuerda que la fe no debe ocultarse. Debe manifestarse en la forma en que amamos, servimos, perdonamos y cuidamos unos a otros.

Qué apropiado que este mensaje llegue ahora que se acerca el día de San Valentín, una fecha que a menudo se asocia únicamente con el amor romántico. Si bien el matrimonio y el romance son dones maravillosos, el amor cristiano es mucho más amplio y profundo. Incluye la amistad, los lazos familiares, la compasión por los vecinos, la amabilidad con los desconocidos y el cuidado de aquellos que se sienten olvidados.

A San Valentín no se le recuerda por los chocolates o las tarjetas, sino por su amor valiente, su servicio a los demás, su bendición a los matrimonios y su testimonio de Cristo incluso en momentos difíciles. El amor verdadero no es solo un sentimiento, es una decisión de buscar el bien de otra persona.

Jesús nos llama a ser luz amando en las cosas cotidianas: una palabra amable cuando alguien está desanimado, paciencia con un familiar, una visita o una llamada telefónica a alguien que se siente solo, una mano amiga ofrecida sin que se pida. 
